Jessi was diagnosed with brain cancer in the spring of 2015. We were referred to Children's Hospital of Michigan for her treatment. Jessi and I live in Saginaw, which is a two-hour drive from Detroit, in the best of conditions. When we

found out she was going to have to be at the hospital every day, Monday through Friday, all day long, for more than six weeks, I wasn't sure how we were going to make that work. There's no way we could drive that far everyday, especially with Jessi sick from the radiation. We couldn't afford to stay in a hotel all week, not on our budget. That's when we found out about the Ronald



bringing in a record turnout of golfers and \$40,000. Be sure to join the fun next year!


