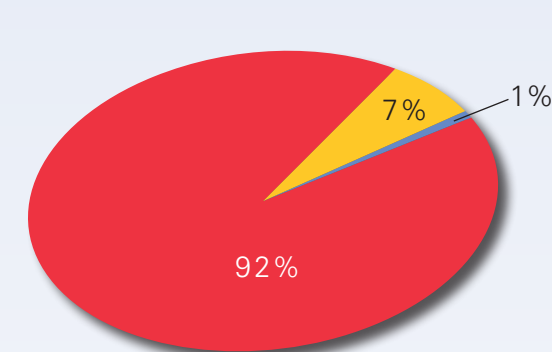
OUR VISION

OUR MISSION

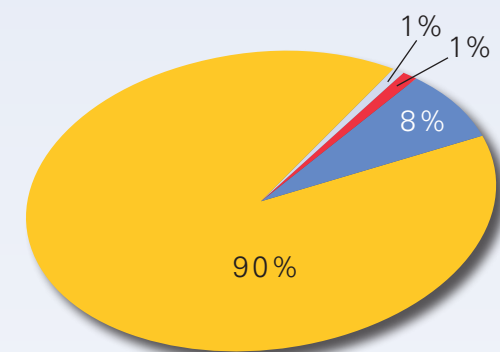

The majority of our funding comes from contributions from kind people like you. The rest comes from our fundraising events, local foundation grants, and the room donations we ask from families (which is sometimes covered by their insurance).

The Ronald McDonald House of Detroit first opened in 1979 and has served nearly 60,000 families in that time, providing them with a "home away from home" while their child is receiving treatment at a Metro Detroit area hospital. Our guest rates remain at \$10 per night and no one is ever turned away for lack of funds. Actual cost for a night's stay is \$250 and our generous supporters help us make up that difference.
