It is an exciting time for the Ronald McDonald House Charities Detroit! We are launching our "Love Drives Us" capital campaign to provide the Detroit House with living area upgrades, securing funds for overnight stays for the families we serve, and making the dreams of our board members and staff come true by bringing a Ronald McDonald Care Mobile™ to the city of Detroit; serving children with minor medical needs and allowing for routine check-ups and vaccines.

Even though our "home away from home" is still beautiful, we are raising funds to freshen up the rooms and common areas. We were fortunate to have a new kitchen and exercise room donated the past two years and now our focus will be on continuing to upgrade the bedrooms and other areas with the funds raised during this campaign.

We no longer ask our families for room fees and part of this campaign will help cover those operational costs. The actual operating cost per night, per room, is \$75 and we don't want any family to be faced with that financial burden, no matter how long their stay may be.

We had a very fun and successful spring and summer and look forward to the launch of "Love Drives Us" this fall and striving to reach our goal within the next three years.

In 2017, Shannon and Daniel Norwood, Sr. got the news that any parent fears; their son, Daniel "Diggy" II, had

been diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. With a strong sense of faith and a lot of hope with family by his side, Daniel's remission came after 30 days; though as the months and years progressed unfortunately so did the cancer. Sending

Daniel into the ICU for 70 days. It was in those pivotal moments that the donations of food, funds and gifts Daniel and his parents received from friends, family and complete strangers, that Shannon says, "made us feel truly blessed and it made the time spent away from work and the long days, including holidays, in the hospital a little more bearable".

Sadly, on February 23rd, 2022 Daniel transitioned to heaven. Leaving his family to carry on his wish of helping other kids, and families, spending days in the hospital at their children's side as they fight for their lives.




