Brooke, who is now 18, has been battling uncontrollable seizures since the first grade and was coming to receive a life altering surgery, and RMHC Detroit was there to comfort them both. Brooke's surgery went very well and they were back in the air in no time; but no trip is complete without a thorough review and Regina did not disappoint. ...your sh<mark>uttle d</mark>river<mark>s wer</mark>e so wonderful. We took the mor<mark>n</mark>ing shuttle for Brooke's surgery and we co<mark>uldn'</mark>t have st<mark>arted</mark> the day with a better person. I swear she was a gift to us that morning. After Brooke's surgery she was so hungry and ordered plain pasta with a Caesar salad fro<mark>m th</mark>e hospital; thou<mark>gh</mark> she was discharged before it got to her. O<mark>ur</mark> afternoon driver was also super kind for helping us in the kitchen when we returned and believe it or not, we found a c<mark>ontainer of plain pas</mark>ta a<mark>nd Caesar salad in the fridge! Brooke g</mark>ot to have the meal she was craving after all, she was so happy! Our stay at your House was a blessing financially, but in so many other ways as well. It was so uplifting to witness so much care and kindness in our world. Thank you again, to all of you, for making our stay so wonderful!"

Since their stay Regina says Brooke is doing great and they are hoping this surgery was the answer they had been looking for. Brooke is a freshman in college studying plant biology and horticulture with an interest in working with plants - possibly for medicinal purposes.


